May we take a fresh look at the things we have rushed past and listen more closely to the sounds we have ignored. Above all, may this be a time when we recognize that God's love and grace fill even the smallest moments of our daily lives.

In the grace of going slow, may we experience the joy of resurrection more deeply.


