Not long ago, I asked to my friend, "How do you manage to remember all the names of the people you meet at church?" He smiled and replied, "It's not about memory—it's about keeping them in my heart. The conversations we share leave a deep impression on me." Indeed, building a community is not just about knowing names and recognizing faces; it's about sharing life stories, joys, and even sorrows with one another.

Meeting new people at church and forming a community with them is a truly special joy. First, welcoming new people to our church. Those coming to church for the first time may feel both excitement and unfamiliarity. By offering them a heartfelt welcome and warm greeting, we can help them experience the love of God in this space.

Second, sharing news of joy and sorrow within the church. Whether it's celebrating milestones like birthdays or weddings or offering comfort and prayer during difficult times, I hope our community can be one that stands together. Through these moments, we can experience God's comfort and love more abundantly.

Third, connecting with our homebound members. Visiting or calling those who cannot attend church due to health issues or other circumstances, sharing bulletins and newsletter, and simply letting them know they are in our prayers can bring great comfort. We want them to know that they are still a welcomed and cherished part of our community.

All of this must be rooted in God's love. As John said, "Dear friends, let us love one another, for love comes from God. Everyone who loves has been born of God and knows God" (1 John 4:7). This love is the core and the driving force behind our ministry.

When we join hands to share the love God has given us, our church will become more than a space for worship—it will be a place that testifies to God's grace for everyone. I earnestly hope our community will grow warmer, richer, and more filled with the boundless love of God.

As we begin this new ministry, I humbly ask for your prayers and support. Building a community is not something we do alone—it's something we create together. Please remember that each one of you is an essential part of this ministry.

Let us journey forward together, sharing God's love and grace with all.






February 8th Events: One day, two opportunities!
